SQL 2008 Installation guide for Cleaners ProfitMaker

Correct installation of SQL Server is critical for the operation of Cleaners ProfitMaker. Please follow these steps to make sure SQL is installed correctly :

Requirements: 64 bit computer running Windows 7, 8, or 10 operating system.

- 1. Your computer must be named "SERVER". Very important, if not, go to Control Panel, rename it to Server and reboot.
- 2. You must have a user named "POS" with <u>administrator</u> rights and a password of "pos".
- 3. Make sure you are logged in as POS, and you had to enter a password of pos.
- 4. Find the **SQLEXPRWT_x64_ENU_2008R2.exe** file and copy it to your harddrive (ie; Downloads).
- 5. From your harddrive location, execute the SQLEXPRWT_x64_ENU_2008R2.exe program.

Follow these steps to correctly set the SQL 2008 options:

ProfitMaker can now be installed simply by following the default installation options from the installation DVD.

Attaching the database

Ok, now you have SQL installed and ProfitMaker installed. The last thing to do is attach the database to SQL. Follow these steps:

- 1. On the ProfitMaker DVD is a folder named "Default Databases".
- 2. Copy the **ProfitPlus.mdf** and **ProfitPlus_log.ldf** files to the folder below:
 - a. C:\Program Files\Microsoft SQL Server\MSSQL10_50.SQLEXPRESS\MSSQL\Data
- 3. Start the **Microsoft SQL Server Management Studio** application from the start menu.
- 4. Right mouse click on the "Databases" item on the left panel .
- 5. Select "Attach"
- 6. Click on "Add"
- 7. In the list of database files, select the **ProfitPlus.mdf** file so it is highlighted.
- 8. Click on the "**Ok**" button to start the attachment.
- 9. If the attach worked, you can now start the ProfitMaker Plus program by clicking on the icon on your desktop.
